Describes a person or animal.

Who is your best friend?


## WHAT



Describes an object or action.

What is that?

## WHEN



Describes a time.

When is your birthday?

## WHERE



Describes a place.

Where did she go?

## WHY



Describes a reason.

Why is it so hot?

## HOW



Describes a number or the way things are done.

How old are you?

# COMMON IRREGULAR VERBS

Irregular verbs don't follow standard conjugation patterns.




Base Form	Simple Past	Past Participle
be	was/ were	been
do	did	done
go	went	gone
have	had	had
say	said	said

# HOMOPHONES

Homophones are two words that sound the same, but have a different meaning and spelling.

Here are some examples:

	blue and blew	
	break and brake	
	peace and piece	
	stare and stair	

# PAST TENSE

**Remember: In past tense, regular verbs end with '-ed,' but watch out for irregular verbs**



Pronoun	To Be	To Have	Regular Verb (-ed)
I	was	had	played
You	were	had	played
He/ She/ It	was	had	played
We	were	had	played
They	were	had	played
